

Wordless Book Instruction Sheet

What you need:

- Plain paper
- Scissors
- Crayons/Pencil crayons/Kokis

How to make your wordless book:

- Cut 5 equal squares from your piece of paper.
- Colour 1 square black, 1 square red, 1 square yellow, 1 square green and leave the last square white.
- Now make your book. You can staple or glue your book or use sticky tape. The order of the pages are black, red, white, yellow and green.
- Learn what each colour means (simplify for younger children) below and then you are ready to tell others the Good News about Jesus, using your Wordless Book.

What each colour of the Wordless Book means:

The Black Page (Romans 3:23)

This page reminds me of sin. Sin is all the bad stuff we do that makes God really sad. We all make bad choices, even adults. The Bible says in Romans 3:23 that "all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." This means that there is nothing that we can do to ever make us good enough to reach God. But there is good news! God planned a way for us to reach Him.

The Red Page (John 3:16)

God's plan was to send His perfect Son, Jesus. Jesus was born and He never sinned. Because of this, He was able to take our place on the cross and die for our sins. But Jesus didn't stay dead. Three days later, Jesus came back to life and then he went back to heaven. Because of what Jesus did for you, you can have your sins forgiven. John 3:16 says, "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life."

The White Page (Psalm 51:7)

Do you see how clean this page is? Do you remember how black your heart is from sin? You don't have to have a black heart. You can have a clean heart. Psalm 51:7 says: "...wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow." Jesus wants to forgive you for all your sins and take them away. His blood will wash away all of that yuckiness and darkness. The Bible also tells us that when Jesus forgives our sins, He totally forgets about them.

The Yellow Page (Rev 21:18, 21)

Yellow reminds me of gold which reminds me of things that are very special. It reminds me of God. God is perfect and He does nothing wrong. It also reminds me of Heaven. Heaven is where God lives. Heaven is a great place, but there is one thing that cannot ever be in Heaven: sin. We learned that the only way to get rid of our sin is to ask Jesus to wipe it away. Do you believe that you have sinned and made wrong choices? Do you believe that Jesus came to forgive you for your sins? Would you like to ask Jesus to come into your heart and make it as white as snow? If the answer is yes, let's pray together. "Dear Jesus, I know I am a sinner and make bad choices. Please forgive me. Thank you, Jesus, for dying for me and forgiving me of my sins. Please come into my life and make it clean. Please help me make good choices and live for You. Thank You for loving me! In Jesus' Name, Amen"

The Green Page (2 Peter 3:18)

Once we ask Jesus into our heart, He changes who we are. We now have Jesus to help us make good choices. The green page reminds us of how Jesus helps us grow into the person He wants us to be! Christians need to pray, read the Bible and spend time with other Christians at church. All three of these things will help Christians grow up in Jesus.

If you have prayed to God and meant it from your heart, then you will go to Heaven when you die! You only have to receive the Lord once. If your family don't know Jesus as their Saviour, please go home and tell them what they can do to go to heaven.
