What lessons have you learnt from our study of the book of Job?
What frustrations or questions do you still have?

Bible Study:

1. READ Job 42:1-6. What does Job mean in verse 5? How has his understanding of God changed through this time of turmoil?
2. What exactly did Job repent of (vs 6)?
3. READ Job 42:7-9. God rebukes Job's friends and vindicates Job. Why is it always better to leave our vindication in God's hands?
4. How is Job a 'type', or foreshadow, of Jesus Christ in this passage?
5. READ Job 42:10-17. List the various blessing - stated and implied - that Job now receives from the Lord!
6. Why is the restoration mentioned in vs 11 so important? See Job 19:13-14.
7. God literally gave Job double what he had before (see 1:3 and 42:12). But Job received only seven more sons and three daughters. Why not double?
8. What applications can we make from this passage? Can we also expect God to restore and double all that we lose?
9. What other restored relationship is implied by vs 13?
10. How would you use the book of Job as a comfort to someone who is going through a period of loss? What is the most helpful message that you glean from this piece of Scripture?
